As of May 31, 2011 the Florida District has 33 clubs, 845 members, 23 Members at Large, which is a net gain of eight members. Way to GROW!!

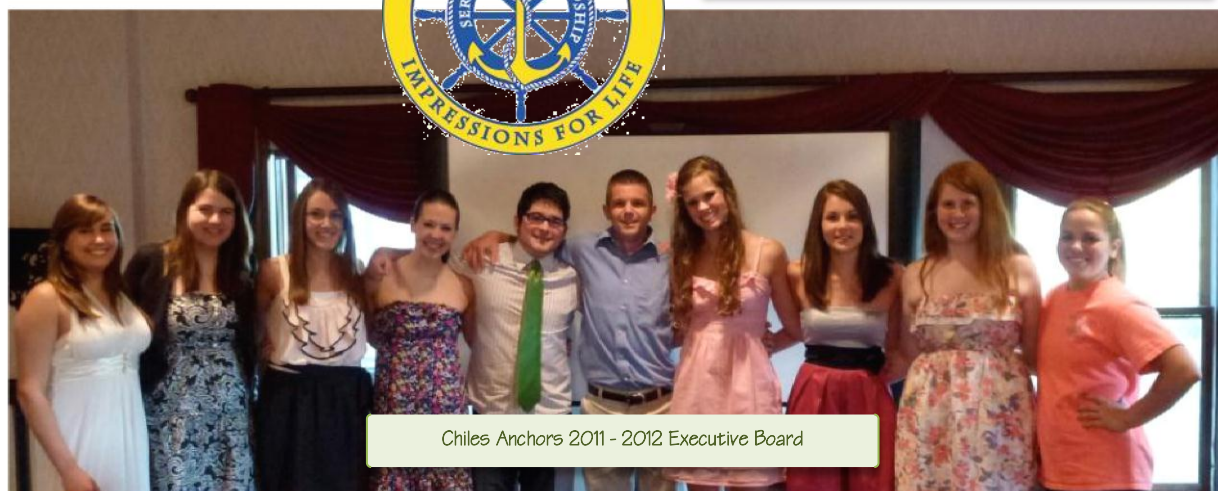


## Anchors Away!
