FOUNDERS FUND

The Founders Fund sponsors four scholarship programs:

- **Pilot International Scholarship** for undergraduate students preparing for a career helping those with brain-related disorders or brain-related disabilities.
- **Becky Burrows Memorial Scholarship** for graduate or undergraduate students preparing for a second career, re-entering the job market or obtaining additional training in their current field. The career path must pertain to assisting those with brain-related disorders or brain-related disabilities.
- **Marie Newton Sepia Memorial Scholarship** for students studying at the master's or doctorate level who are preparing for a career helping children with brain-related disorders or brain-related disabilities.
- **Ruby Newhall Memorial Scholarship** for students from outside the United States pursuing a degree in either the US or Canada in a field of study of such nature that it improves the quality of life for the community in the student's home country.

All applicants for a Founders Fund scholarship must be sponsored by a Pilot Club in their hometown, or in the city in which their college or university is located. We will not respond to any applications received from a prospective Founders Fund recipient without appropriate signatures by a Pilot Club president.
